At 00:12hrs on 24/11/2020 at Dunchurch Road, Rugby


Police responded to suspicious activity and arrested three men stealing diesel from HGVs



A delivery Lorry was entered and Police responded












STAFFORDSHIRE – HGV CRIME ARRESTS



LANCASHIRE - BOGUS HAULIER - HAULAGE EXCHANGE - LOAD FRAUD

NaVCIS are working with colleagues at Lancashire Police

NaVCIS reported on Bulletin 024 of 27/11/2020 that haulage exchanges are being used by Criminals to steal trailer loads of goods by using bogus documentation namely insurance documents & operators licences

On 30/11/2020 at Walton Summit, Preston, Lancashire – a trailer load of goods was stolen & Police believe that the male pictured on CCTV may have information that can assist enquiries

Code D of PACE

The following instructions must be followed by officers to ensure identifications can be actioned and are admissible in court.

All persons viewing images must follow the below procedures, as you may be called to court to account for your actions. You must view the images alone, your identifications must be yours and yours only. If you recognise a suspect, do not discuss this with colleagues; send the information to the OIC as soon as possible.

Your Identification statement must cover the below

- 1. Whether you were alone when viewing images, and if not the reasons why.
- 2. Image ref number.
- 3. Full details of subject as known to you.
- 4. Reasons for recognition i.e. facial features, gait, distinctive clothing or a combination of all.
- 5. How long you have known them.
- 6. How you know them.
- 7. Whether you recognise the place shown in the footage

NaVCIS have received further notifications of Bogus Haulier / Load Frauds during the last two weeks involving Haulage Exchanges

DUE DILIGENCE – In relation to Businesses using Haulage Exchanges

To avoid becoming a victim – Ensure thorough checks are conducted in relation to the validity of the driver collecting the load – a simple phone call to a **landline** of the business or the said haulier can assist and / or a **photograph of the driver collecting**

It is prudent to conduct thorough checks - <u>do not simply rely on an Insurance Document or</u>

<u>Operators Licence</u> which can and are being forged to steal trailer loads of goods
